Mentoring in the college has been practised for over 8 years. In the beginning Department of Education was requested to prepare a conducted in the college. Format for recording mentoring sessions was prepared. This was circulated to every department since m departments according to the time and place available for them. Mentoring book was distributed to each teacher. Every teacher depending on the number of students and teachers in each department. The average number each teacher had was about 10 to 15 meeting between mentors and mentees, some teachers opened Whatsapp group for mentoring purpose only. The teacher mentor p academic subjects such as importance of having good attendance, giving internal tests, also learning techniques etc. Student men questions to their assigned teacher mentors concerning academic as well as personal issues. Some teacher mentors identified studer taken care of between them without disclosing such issues in the open. On experiencing closer relationship with their teachermento stressed the importance of mentoring by mentioning how they could have less back papers had mentoring been introduced earlier (n among the final year students). It is found the mentoring in the college has positive feedback both from the teacher mentors as we survey is not conducted. It is expected to be followed with more emphasis in the future
